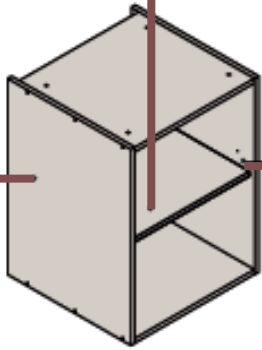

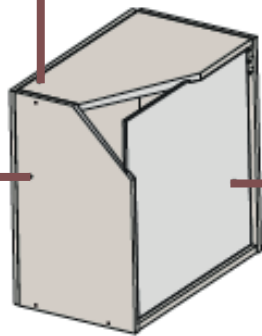

Phenolic Plywood

Phenolic plywood or marine board is a material that meets the highest demands for resistance.

It is configured with thin solid wood veneers joined together with phenolic glues.

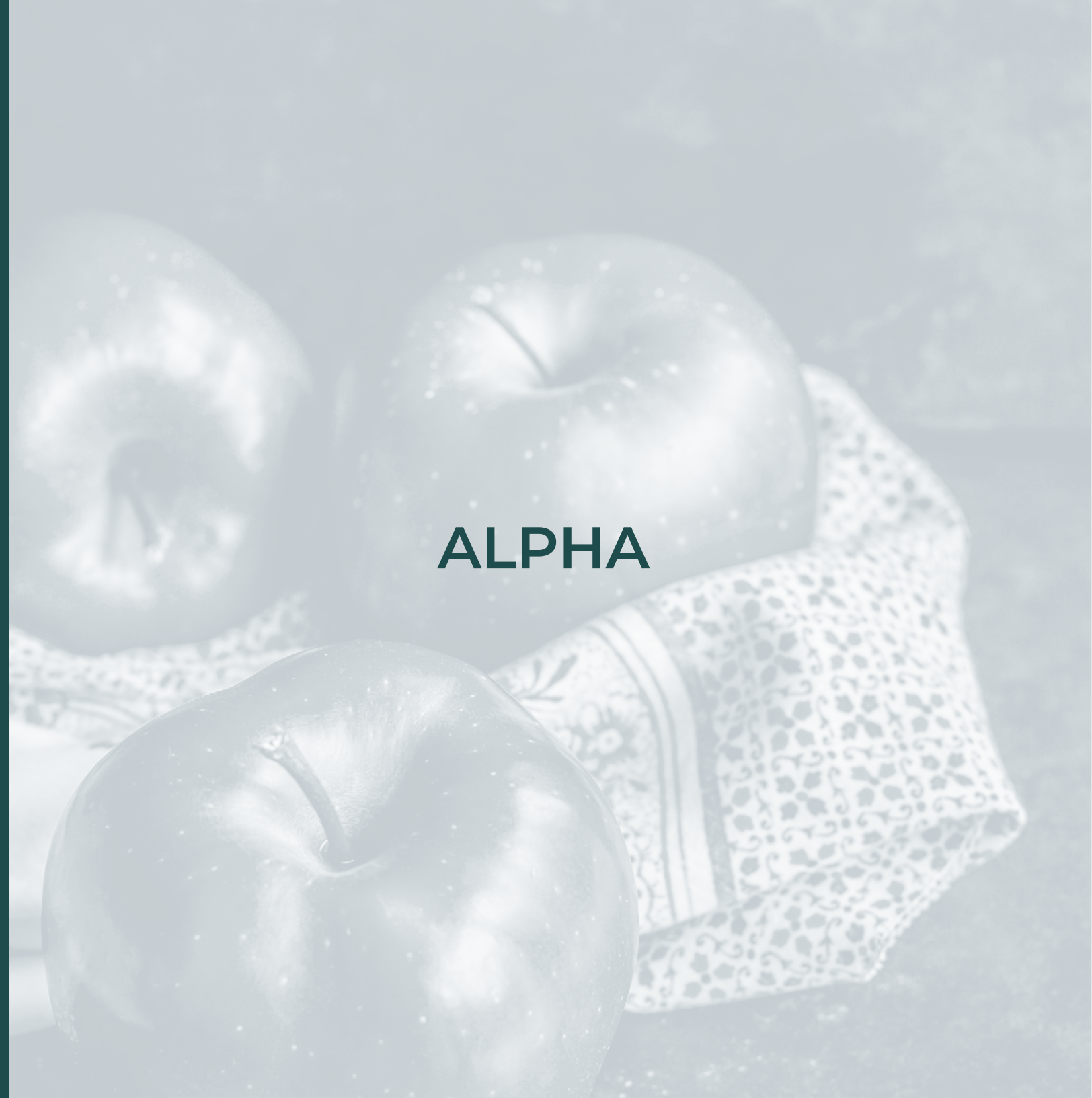
This construction gives it high resistance to wear and tear as well as great stability in extreme and humid conditions.

For all these reasons, it is a board widely used in industry and for intensive use, such as boat decks, truck platforms, construction, formwork, stage flooring, etc.

Koher proposes the use of plywood board (normally made of Birch veneer) in environments more exposed to humidity and shocks, thus providing a higher level of resistance to continuous use.
